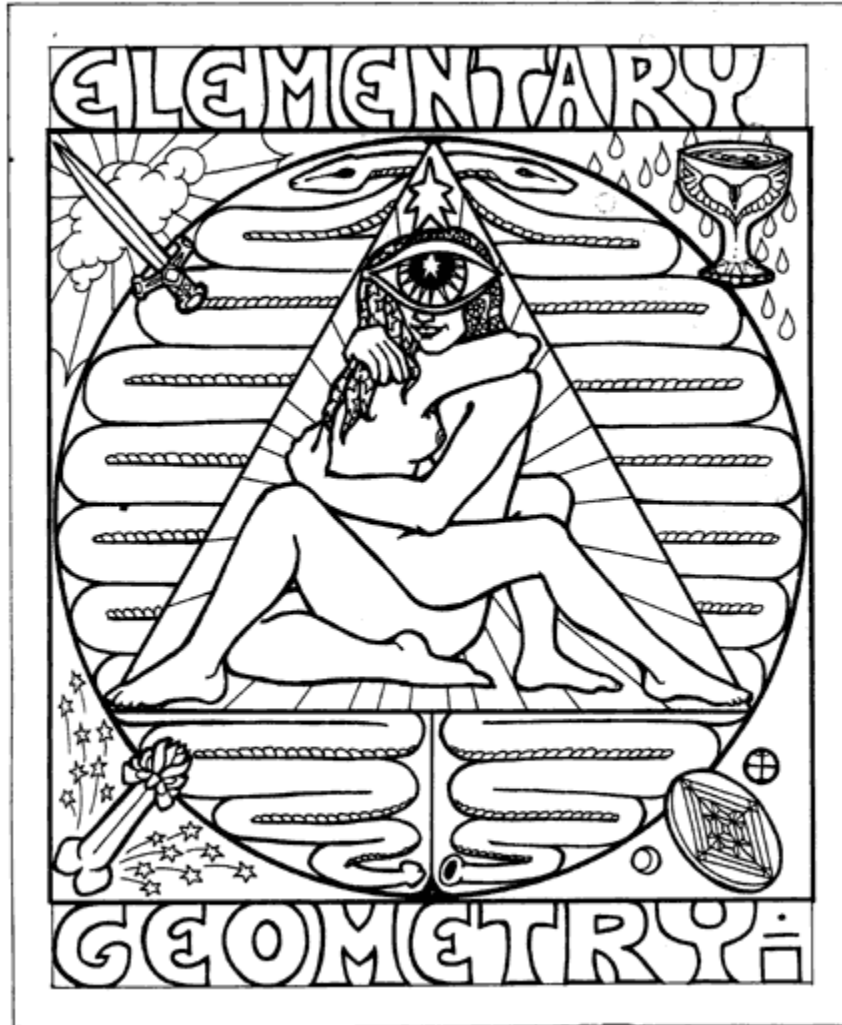
TOPICS IN GEOMETRY (G 2-5)
